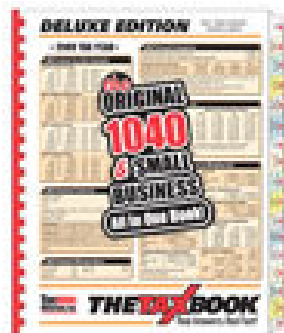
Fastax disc

Special Enrollment Exam Logistics

When: You'll be able to take *each* Part of the exam FOUR times during the 2007 window, from May 2008 to February 2009. If you fail, you must wait 2 weeks between attempts.

Locations: The exam is now offered globally, wherever Prometric has a facility.

FEES: The testing fee is \$101 for each part of the examination = \$303 for all three parts (There is a \$35 fee to reschedule 5-29 days before exam. Full price if 5 days before exam.)
